General Rules & Information

1. The Points Program is composed of KJCA members working with the community in promoting, educating about beef. Participants will be graded by their cumulative points reported and earned throughout the year.
2. Entry is open to any KJCA member 9-21 years of age.
3. Participants will be assigned to one of the following age divisions for all competitions:
Senior (17-21), Intermediate (13-16), Junior (9-12). Age is determined as of **January 1, 2023**.
4. Copies may be made of the entry forms, rules, and regulations.
5. Points can start being accumulated on October 5th, 2023 and are due back October 15th of 2024.
6. Participants are responsible for recording and submitting their own points. The committee and/or KCA staff reserves the right to check on validity of any participation claimed on the participants entry form.
7. Only 1 set of points will be awarded for each activity. Example- If you show at the State Fair, you will only be awarded 5 points for the entire fair. No separate points given for heifer/steer show.
8. Completed entry forms must be submitted by **October 15, 2024**. If they are not received by this date, then the participants forfeit their right to be a part of the program.
9. Points **DO NOT** roll over from year to year. Each participant begins at 0 points.
10. It is the responsibility of the participant to record all their own points and gather the supporting documents. **KCA staff and witnesses will not be responsible for “remembering” that the junior was present at an event.**
11. Each participant is required to write Thank You notes to sponsors of the program.
12. All questions concerning the rules will be referred to the KJCA Points Program Committee. Their decision is final. Violation of the rules and/or forgery of points and their consequences will be determined by the committee.
13. All participant points from each county will be totaled together to reach a combined score. The top 3 counties will be recognized with a monetary prize.

Earning Points

1. All KJCA Points Program Participants must keep track of their own points.
2. Each KJCA Participant is required to submit a Points Program Application and supporting documents by **DATE**. All applications received after that date will be considered voided.
3. All participants must submit a picture (date, location, event name, etc.) and or a certificate with a **leader's signature** confirming that you were present.
4. Participant must be present for the majority of each event that is claimed.
5. If a participant is using social media and/or podcasts/blog, writing the date of the post and tagging KY Cattlemen's Association & KY Beef Council in the post will suffice.
6. If an event or other category is not present in points breakdown page, then the participant will need to submit a claim to the committee for allotted points.
7. In the case that there is a tie, the tie will be broken based on the total number of events participated in, or by the determination of the committee.

Prizes and Awards Recognition

1. Awards will be given out at the Annual Kentucky Cattlemen's Convention hosted in January.
2. Each category (Junior, Intermediate, and Senior) will have a high points winner (Member of the Year.)
3. The county award will combine all the points of the participants in the county. The top county will receive a monetary stipend to their local Cattlemen's chapter, to be used for their juniors/junior programming.
